American Legion Riders,

It has come to my attention that a few of you have incorrectly interpreted the adopted 60 day extension to the implementation of the **Uniform Manual** to the compliance with the adoption of our revised **ALR By-laws**. **This is incorrect.**

To clarify, AL Resolution 15-004 went into effect on March 15, 2015; ALR By-law revision, containing AL Resolution 15-004, went into effect on April 18, 2015. Compliance with the ALR By-laws is mandatory at this time and has nothing to do with the Uniform Manual that was adopted.

It is up to the ALR Chapter Presidents to ensure that all AL Riders in their Chapter are currently in compliance with ALR DOC By-laws. Action by the Chapter to suspend those members who are out of compliance should begin immediately. In addition, American Legion Rider Chapter Presidents will be held accountable for the actions and uniforms of their Riders. The ALR DOC will otherwise immediately bring action, including Charter Suspension, per the Trial Manual, on any ALR Chapter out of compliance.
